



## Towns County High School Online Learning Plan

Towns County High School will use GradPoint to deliver core content instruction to students who select the online learning option. GradPoint is a student-centered learning platform that engages students and empowers them to take ownership of their learning with student choice and learning incentives. Teachers act as coaches to differentiate, intervene, and motivate students in their personalized learning pathway of rigorous, standards-based instruction.

	Online Learning Plan
<b>Class structure</b>	Class content will be delivered through the GradPoint online platform.
<b>Teachers</b>	Content is delivered online with support from teacher facilitators as needed. Assigned teachers will serve as facilitators to work with students on completing assignments.
<b>Time spent</b>	Students are expected to login to their online course at the scheduled time for the class that mirrors that of the traditional school. For example, students should login at 8:00 AM for their first block class.
<b>Extracurricular Activity participant requirements</b>	Online Learning students participating in extracurricular activities will be required to meet the same requirements as traditional students.
